Broadway House for Continuing Care Receives Excellent Rating from Department of Health

(Newark, NJ) Broadway House for Continuing Care recently concluded its annual survey with the **New Jersey Department of Health** resulting in a clinically deficiency-free survey.

The State of New Jersey inspects licensed and certified healthcare facilities to ensure the safety of patients and residents and a consistently high quality of care.

Inspection teams evaluate all aspects of resident care and facility procedures and practices, compliance with more than 1500 stated and federal standards is assessed focusing on the fitness and adequacy of the nursing facility. The team also reviews resident rights, access to care, dietary services, housekeeping and staffing.

Broadway House, a long-term care facility that specializes in caring for people living with HIV/AIDS, also recently received a **5 Star Quality Rating** (highest rating) from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. The rating system is to help consumers, families and caregivers compare nursing homes more easily and to help identify areas about which they may want to ask questions.

Additionally, Broadway House/New Beginnings, has received **Providigm's Basic QAPI Accreditation for 2017** as a skilled nursing facility actively performing Quality Assurance and Performance Improvement activities. Just over 300 centers in the United States earned this accreditation for 2017.

The QAPI Accreditation recognizes that Broadway House is continually assessing residents' quality of life and quality of care issues against federal regulation at an ongoing rate and correcting identified issues.
